Upgrade Procedure

<u>Grade 7 Adult Amateur Referee to Grade 6 – State Referee</u>

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Minimum 75 USSF affiliated games U16 and above
 - o Minimum 50 games as Referee
 - o Minimum 25 games as Assistant Referee
- Minimum 2 years as Grade 7 referee

If you meet the above requirements and wish to upgrade from Grade 7 to Grade 6 follow the procedure in the order as shown below:

- A. Complete a game log: list games you officiated that meet the requirement and submit with a request to upgrade to the referee office at MJRefOffice@verizon.net . Game Log form can be download from www.NJREFS.com
- B. Upon review of your game log, you will be notified if you qualify for upgrade.
 - 1. If you do not have enough games at U16 and above, you will not be eligible to upgrade.
 - 2. If you are eligible you will be notified how to register for the Grade 6 Upgrade Clinic. Special registration code will be required.
- C. Register for the Grade 6 Upgrade Clinic and Exam on NJSRC.GameOfficials.net
- D. Pass the Grade 6 exam with a minimum score of 80%.
- E. Attend the Grade 6 Upgrade Clinic.
- F. Pass the State Referee Sprint and Interval Fitness Test
- G. Minimum of 2 passing assessments by two different State Assessors and at least 1 of these assessment must be from an adult game.
