



Grade 9 Entry Level Course Information and Instructions

Grade 9 Entry Level Class General Information:

- Students must be 14 years of age on or prior to the classroom session.
- Bring your confirmation e-mail to the class to confirm you are registered
- You must attend the one day class in its entirety.
- Classes are held each day from 8:30 AM until approximately 4:30 PM.
- Students will be given an opportunity to contact their parents (rides) about an hour before the end of the class.
- The in class test, given at the end of the day, is 50 questions and passing is 75%.
- Bring a Number 2 pencil to take the exam
- Bring paper and pencils/pens to take notes. Law books and other handouts will be provided.
- Bring your own lunch/snacks/drink as these are not provided.
- Cell phones must be turned off and anyone using the phone during class will be dismissed.
- There are any number of search engines (Google, MapQuest etc.) that provide maps and directions for the venue.
- If you do not pass the test you have 90 days to re-take and pass online. Otherwise you will have to repeat the course in full.
- Successful completion allows the individual to officiate recreational games. Officiating travel soccer matches is NOT permitted.
- The individual usually obtains assignments from the in-town recreational referee coordinator. Contact your town's program for more information.

Class Fees: the class fee covers all registration fees, classroom expenses

To register for a course:

1. Go to www.NJREFS.com and click on the **Becoming A Referee** tab and click on the Register For Grade 9 Entry Level Class. You will create an account in this system in order to register.
2. After you have created your account, click **COURSES** (left sidebar) and choose the course for which you want to register
3. You will pay via Visa or MasterCard
